After a roll call took place, a quorum was confirmed.

2. Additions, Deletions, and Changes to the Agenda

There were no additions, deletions, or changes to the agenda.

3. Approval of February 22, 2024, Meeting and Public Hearing Minutes\*

Kara Tucker motioned for the approval of the meeting minutes. Carla Jenkins seconded the motion. The February 22, 2024, Meeting and Public Hearing minutes were approved unanimously.

#### 4. Regional Mobility Group

Eric Houston with the Regional Mobility Group and Jacksonville Transportation Authority (JTA) gave a presentation on the Northeast Florida Coordinated Mobility Plan.

The Northeast Florida Coordinated Mobility Plan is a regional effort. The purpose of the plan is to identify transportation needs of individuals with disabilities, older adults, and people with low incomes. It also provides strategies for meeting these needs and prioritizes transportation services for funding and implementation. The schedule to implement the plan is approximately September during the regional meeting with LCB members. There was also a survey shared at the end of the presentation.

Van Christiansen from The Haskell Company gave a presentation on Creating Safe Spaces Action Plan. Van Christiansen updated us on the Action Plan progress. Over the past couple of months, the Haskell Company has been diligently conducting research and analysis to better understand last mile safety needs in the region. There was a survey shared at the end of the presentation.

#### 5. LCB Membership

Ms. Jones went over the LCB Membership and the vacancies. Currently there are five (5) vacancies which include: Veterans Services, Elderly, Children at Risk, Private-for-Profit Transportation, and Local Medical Community.

Ms. Jones introduced the new member Russ Davis, who is representing Persons with Disabilities. Mr. Davis gave a brief introduction of himself.

#### 6. Annual Review of Bylaws\*

There were no additions, deletions, or changes to the Annual Review of Bylaws. Kara Tucker motioned for the approval of the Annual Review of Bylaws. Carla Jenkins seconded the motion. The Annual Review of the Bylaws was approved unanimously.

#### 7. Northeast Florida Regional Council Update\*

Ms. Jones gave an update for the Northeast Florida Regional Council.

She attended the FPTA/FDOT/CUTR Workshop June 3, 2024, in Tampa, FL. She stated it went well. There was also a CTD Meeting held in Tampa, FL. At that meeting, the CTD approved JTA to be the CTC for Nassau County.

The Northeast Florida Regional Council will be relocating to the Jessie Ball DuPont Center at 40 E Adams Street. The anticipated relocation is expected to be at the end of July/beginning of August. More information will be sent out as the date gets closer.

a) TDSP Annual Review (Roll Call Vote)\*

Complete verbiage in the Liaison Activities – page 140 – There was verbiage of the liaison activities description that was previously included. After further review, it was observed that verbiage was missing. Ms. Tucker motioned to approve the TDSP with the proposed amendment. Ms. Jenkins seconded the motion. After the roll-call vote, the TDSP passed unanimously.

- b) Proposed LCB Meeting Schedule 2:00 pm on the 1st Thursday Quarterly, 4th Thursday in February: 9/5/24, 11/7/24, 2/27/25, 5/1/25, 9/4/25\*
  Ms. Tucker motioned to approve the schedule. Mr. O'Connor seconded the motion. The meeting schedule passed unanimously.
- c) Proposed LCB Annual Hearing 4th Thursday in February: 2/27/25\*
  Ms. Tucker motioned to approve the schedule. Mr. O'Connor seconded the motion. The meeting schedule passed unanimously.
- d) CTC Evaluation\*

Ms. Jones reviewed the results of this year's CTC evaluation. There were no reported findings. Ms. Tucker motioned to approve the annual evaluation. Mr. O'Connor seconded the motion. The annual evaluation passed unanimously.

#### 8. Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) System Update

- a. CTC Quarterly Update
  - Ridership Numbers January = 22,757 riders, February = 23,165 riders, March = 23,396 riders.
  - Completed trips –January = 20,840 completed trips, February = 21,231 completed trips, March = 21,396 completed trips.
  - On-time performance has increased. The average on-time performance for January to March is 90.83%.
- b. 2024-2025 Rate Model\*
  - Mr. Poirer reviewed the 2024-2025 Rate Model. Mr. Poirier presented the new rate model, which represents slight increases from the previous year due to higher operating costs. The new rates are:
  - Ambulatory \$35.85/trip
  - Wheelchair \$61.46/trip

Mr. O'Connor made a motion to approve the 2024-2025 Rate Model. Ms. Jenkins seconded the motion. The 2024-2025 Rate Model passed unanimously.

- c. Grants Update\*
  - There are currently no grants updates.

#### 11. Public Comment

There was no public comment.

#### 12. Member and Department Reports

She also stated this would be a good opportunity to have the Northeast Florida Coordinated Mobility Plan and Creating Safe Spaces Action Plan surveys completed.
